

Sheffield Concord Netball Club code for using EISS facilities

These additional notes are to be read and understood in conjunction with the SCNC code of conduct

Entering the building is via the same main entrance (as before)

Inside the building, face masks/coverings must be worn in all general areas

Follow Sheffield City Trust/NGB guidelines and signage on appropriate social distancing during activity and changes to session delivery

Access to the netball courts is via reception and turn right (as before)

Participants should arrive (and leave) with as little time before/after their session, to reduce time in the venue – start and finish times will be notified in advance

EISS will not provide any changing facilities or water fountain for drink refills

Toilet facilities are available but subject to local house rules about numbers at any one time

Spectators are allowed but not on court. The balcony is available subject to social distancing and the wearing of face masks/coverings

Parents/guardians who must remain on site due to age/vulnerability of participants will be allowed court side within the 30 per court restriction – face masks/coverings to be worn

SCNC have allowed time between groups for cleaning and to reduce risk of participants clustering

Ensure any shared equipment is cleaned between use

Participants bring their own equipment, where applicable, and that it is clearly identifiable by name

Exiting the building after participation will be via fire exits located adjacent to each court. Parents are requested to wait outside, not congregate on court, while maintaining social distancing

The reception café will be open between 14.30 and 19.30, subject to site rules which are clearly signposted, and the vending machines will be operating
